**School Registration:** This document is due on September 14, 2012. You may fax it to the number below or mail it to Christi Tamayo at the address below.

**IRB/SRC Pre-approval meeting** – October 26<sup>th</sup>, 3:00pm at Lake Highland Preparatory School. SRC/IRB paperwork for any projects involving humans, vertebrate animals, animal tissues, bacteria/pathogens/microorganisms, controlled substances must be presented at this meeting.

**SRC/Registration meeting:** A science fair representative is required to attend the January 21<sup>st</sup> meeting at Lake Highland Prep for final paperwork clearance for **ALL** projects entering the Ying Expo.

**Registration:** A science fair representative is required to be on site at Rollins College, February 12, 2012 from 1:00-4:00pm

**Chaperone during Judging** A science fair representative is required to be on site during judging, February 13, 2012 from 8:00 a.m. until student dismissal (about 1:00pm)

It is expected that each school will hold a School Science and Engineering Fair to select **QUALITY** projects to send to the YingExpo. **ALL school fairs should be held by than January 13<sup>th</sup> in order to have time to compile entry packets for the YingExpo. (All ENTRY PACKETS are due January 21<sup>st</sup>) Students with incomplete packets may not be allowed to set up on Feb 12<sup>th</sup> at Rollins College.**
